Carbon dioxide (CO₂) and other greenhouse gases, nitrogen oxides (NO_x), sulfur dioxide (SO₂), and particulate matter (PM_{2.5} and PM₁₀) are only some of the harmful substances caused by the combustion of fossil fuels. Because each of these types of pollution causes its own set of environmental and health problems, offsetting all emissions is vital to environmental protection and personal health.

Leonardo Academy's Cleaner and Greener® Events Certification Program:

- Calculates the emissions footprint caused by energy use associated with the event
- Works with the event host to achieve the desired level of emissions offsets
- Recognizes the event for the [level of offsets](#) achieved

Cleaner and Greener® event calculations include, but are not limited to, emissions caused by:

- Energy use at the event location
- Travel to and from the event by vendors, attendees, and others
- Meal preparation
- Hotel use
